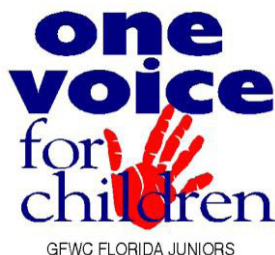
President's Note

Symbolism of GFWC Emblem

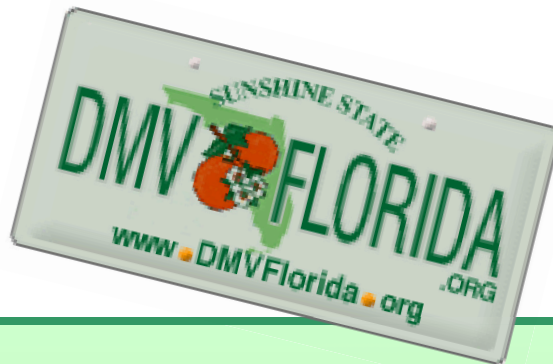

Time to renew your driver's license? It's not as easy as it used to be. New documentation requirements are in effect for Florida residents wishing to renew their license or ID card, obtain a new license, legally change their name prior to renewal date, or immediately replace a lost or stolen license.

Here are the documents that will be required:

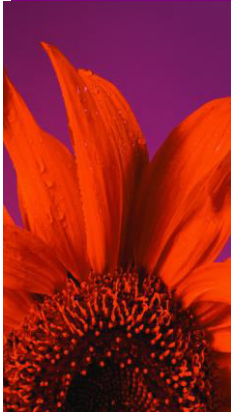
Identification - old license, passport or certified copy of birth certificate.

Social Security Card

Two (2) forms proving residential address: electric bill, voters registration or vehicle registration.

Women Only - Marriage certificate, if married more than once, you will need EACH marriage certificate to follow the path of name changes.

Everyone is encouraged to visit the website GatherGoGet.com to find out how and when to gather your documents. Our Local Tax Collectors office is open in town Wednesdays from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm or you can go to the courthouse in Bronson.
