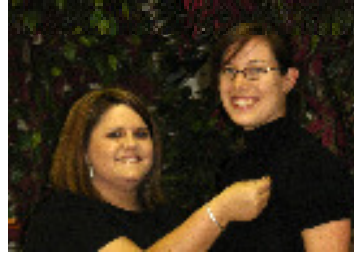

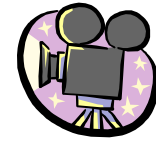

With the lazy days of summer fastly approaching, the first thing on everyone's mind when they walk out in the Florida heat is lounging poolside. Here are a couple of safety tips for a summer's worth of water activities, that will ensure a safer, happier summer for everyone.

SWIM SAFETY

- Buddy Up- Always swim with a partner
